GENERALIA

1. (...v)v·v̇·'v̇ ~ v·v̇·'v̇ (Ivšić: v·v̇·'v̇) e. g. *sramōt'a* 'shame', *vručīn'a* 'fervour'.
2. (·)v̇·'v̇(·) ~ v̇·'v̇ e. g. *vōd'a* 'water', *māgl'a* 'mist'.
3. (...v)v·v̇·'v̇ ≠ v·v̇·'v̇; (·)v̇·'v̇(·) ≠ v̇·'v̇ e. g. *sramōtē*, *vručīnē*, *vōdē*, *māglē*.
4. /ř̄/ > /ř̃/ e. g. *cř̄n'* 'black', G *bř̄z'a* 'fast'.

5. In consequence, 'ř̄·(v...) > ·ř̄· (i.e. a.p. C > a. p. A) e. g. *tř̄g*, *tř̄ga*, *prikò trga* 'square'.
6. a. p. D: *'grōm* : *gròm'a* 'thunder', *'bōr* : *bòr'a* 'pine'.
7. Imparisyllaba with inconsistent lengthening: *güşter* 'lizard' : *kāmēn* 'stone'.
8. /-^lā̄, -^lima/ (Cavtat), /-ā̄, -ima/ (Dubrovnik).
9. All fem. given names have two forms, one of which belongs to a.p. A (rural) and the other to a.p. B (urban).

10. Circumflex type preserved e. g. *'glâdan* : *glâdn'a* 'hungry'.
11. Some monosyllabic adjectives shorten their stem when in definite form e. g. *sûx* : *sûxī* 'dry'.

NUMERI

12. Cardinal numerals become proclitics when preceding *gen. partitūuus* or *gen. mēnsūræ*.

13. No analogical lengthening in *sēdmī* ‘7th’, *ōsmī* ‘8th’.
